

This is the Bayou School near Big Piney. The picture and names were given by Emma Page Hicks. The teacher was George Phillips of Crocker, Mo. The picture is of the term beginning Sept. 1, 1899 and ending in March 31, 1900. There are 81 pupils in this picture and just one teacher. All in one long school room with three rows of seats and black boards all around the wall. This pictures was taken in 1899.

In 1906 they built a new two story school house on the ground where the school is now in Big Piney, Mo. The school was divided into two groups — fourth grade and up and fourth grade and down. Mr. Alex Hickey taught the upper grades and I taught the fourth

grade and down on the lower floor, beginning 1906.
