Richland, Mo.

In 1924, Richland was a busy community along the railroad. Shipments from the town in the 12 months prior to October of 1924 saw train cars full of goods including 235 cars of beef cattle, 127 cars of hogs, two cars of sheep, six cars of wheat, 150 cars of (railroad) ties, 10 cars of walnut logs, three cars of tomatoes, one car of pickles, 7,200 cases of eggs, 4,300 coops of chickens, 178,147 pounds of butter fat, 5,000 green salt hides, 20,000 pounds of wool, 10,000 pounds of mohair, one car of apples, 300 crates of strawberries and \$60,000 worth of raw furs. Ten cars of dairy cattle were shipped in and distributed among the Richland area dairy farmers during the

Richland occupied the conspicuous position in the heart of the popular summer resort section drawing visitors travelling by the Frisco from near and far. Some seven resorts were close by and tributary to Richland.

The Clover Leaf Fair was held early with Pulaski, Camden, Miller and Laclede counties participating. Local competitions, games, and entertainment on a grand scale drew area residents.

Richland had just completed a new 21 room modern high school building. The school system included a four year high school with vocational classes in agriculture.

The city of Richland sported three churches with five resident ministers along with various secret and Fraternal Societies usually found in cities of its size. Richland was home of the oldest bank in Pulaski county with \$75,000 capital and surplus and resources of over one-half million dollars, a city hall, an electric light plant, long distance telephone system, three general stores, three variety stores, three produce houses, a millinery and notion store, fur house, two


